This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. was filed to quash criminal complaint No.3232 of 2016, under Section 138 read with Section 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, along with all the consequential proceedings, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Karnal.

2. As per order dated 23.02.2018, prayer was made by the counsel for the petitioners to place on record certain additional documents. No such documents ever placed on record and in the circumstances, the Court vide order dated 20.07.2018 directed to adjourn the case sine die and to put up the same as and when appropriate application is moved in this regard.

3. File has been taken up today, as per direction of the authorities. No application till date has been moved on behalf of the petitioners. Counsel for the petitioner, Shri R.K. Bajaj has been duly informed through e-mail, as reported by the Registry, but nobody has turned up to represent the petitioners.

4. In the aforesaid circumstances, present petition is hereby dismissed for want of prosecution.

It is hereby made clear that no interim stay regarding proceedings before the Trial Court was ever granted in this case.
