1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.3 to consider and decide representation dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law in a time bound manner.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Siddharth Attri, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State who on instructions from ASI Malkeet Singh submits that land dispute is going on is going on between the private parties and the petitioner should approach the civil Court for redressal of his grievance. It is further submitted that however, in case any such representation submitted by the petitioner is pending the same will be disposed of by the competent authority in accordance with law at the earliest.
4. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide representation dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law within a

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period of one month of the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, it is made clear that any observation made herein above and the decision taken by the competent authority on the basis of representation Annexure P-2 will be having no bearing in the civil litigation if any pending or is initiated in the near future with regard to land in question.
