This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the representations dated 17.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) and 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner in a fair, impartial and expeditious manner in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-8), within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the earlier representation dated 17.02.2024 (Annexure P-7) was consigned to record room on 27.03.2024, which stands approved by the Commissioner of Police on 01.03.2024 and undertakes to convey the decision taken in the said representation, which was not actually conveyed to the petitioner earlier.

Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P-8) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
