1. In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that he should be considered for the post of clerk under the category of dependent of ex-servicemen (Disability above 50% or killed) instead of ESM General category. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that keeping in view the instructions given by him, the benefit claim has already been extended to the petitioner keeping in view the letter dated 13.09.2023 and the petitioner’s claim is being considered under the category of dependent of ex-servicemen hence, the relief claim has already been granted to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case the petitioner is being considered in the category of dependent of ex-servicemen, and as he fulfills the criteria as prescribed in the advertisement dated 20.06.2019 (Annexure R-1) and comes in the zone of consideration with any merit, the further benefit be granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that keeping in view the merit obtained by the petitioner, his claim is being considered in the category of dependent of ex-servicemen and in case, on the basis of the

merit obtained by the petitioner if he is entitled for any further benefit the same will also be extended to him within a further period of 8 weeks by passing an appropriate order.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of.

5. Ordered accordingly.
