In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that vide order dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P/5) though, the benefit of regularization of service from the date the petitioner was entitled for, alongwith arrears for 38 months, has already been granted by the respondents but the said order has not been implemented by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no impediment in the implementation of the order dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P/5) hence, the respondents be directed to implement the said order in a time bound manner so that no further prejudice is caused to the petitioner.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record with his able assistance.

Once, an order has already been passed in favour of the petitioner granting him certain benefit by the respondents themselves, the respondents are under an obligation to implement the said order. Hence, the respondents are directed to implement the order dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P/5) within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and for whatever benefits the petitioner will become entitled under the said order, be released to him within a time frame granted.

Present petition stands disposed of in above terms.
