This is the second petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., whereby, the petitioner has sought the relief of him being granted the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.110 dated 18.07.2021, under Section 15(C) of the N.D.P.S. Act, 1985, registered at P.S. Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

2. The petitioner's earlier petition, i.e. CRM-M-19260-2022, wherein, he had sought an alike relief, as claimed herein, was dismissed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 18.07.2022.
