This application has been filed under Section 528 Cr.P.C. to add Sections 379-A and 452 IPC in the array of offences in the main case bearing FIR No. 185 dated 27.04.2024 under Section 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Munak, Karnal.

Application is allowed and offence under Sections 379-A and 452 IPC in the array of offences in the main case bearing FIR No. 185 dated 27.04.2024 under Section 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Munak, Karnal are ordered to be added.

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1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 185 dated 27.04.2024

under Sections 379-A, 452, 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Munak, Karnal.

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2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karnail Singh submits that in compliance of order dated 31.05.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

3. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed. Resultantly, interim bail order dated 31.05.2024 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.

4. This order should not be treated as "blanket" order. It will not be read granting the petitioner indefinite protection from arrest. It shall be confined to the FIR mentioned *ibid* and will not operate in respect of any other incident that involves commission of an offence.

5. This order does not in any manner limit or restrict the rights or duties of the police or investigating agency to investigate into the charges against the petitioner.

6. It will be open to the police or the investigating agency to move to this Court for a direction under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. to arrest the accused, in the event of violation of any term, such as absconding, non-cooperating during investigation, evasion, intimidation or inducement to witnesses with a view to influence outcome of the investigation or trial.
