1. This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to handover/transfer the inquiry/investigation of the complaint/representation dated 17.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) to some senior IPS officer or to any independent agency/SIT outside the State of Haryana.

2. Faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in case titled *Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, reported as 2008(2) SCC 409* and in *M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, Criminal Appeal No.102 of 2011, decided on 20.03.2020*, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue alternative remedies in accordance with law.



3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
4. It is further submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner and his family members are also apprehending danger to their life and on the said aspect, seeks liberty to file a fresh petition on the said plea alone.
5. With respect to the prayer seeking protection of life and liberty, the petitioner is granted liberty to file a fresh petition after giving the details with respect to the security concern the petitioner and his family members are facing.
