1. On 28.05.2024, this Court had passed the hereinafter extracted order,
upon the instant petition:-

“While placing reliance upon the order passed by this Court in CRM-M-25416-2024, whereby, co-accused Mukesh has been granted the relief of interim relief, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is on co-pedestal and, therefore, he is also entitled for the same relief.

Notice of motion for 29.7.2024.

Interim directions in the same terms as in CRM-M-25416-2024.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-25416-2024.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of connected case.”

2. Today, the learned State counsel has, on instructions imparted to him from the official respondent, stated that pursuant to the making of the hereinabove extracted order, the petitioner had joined investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

3. In view of the above, the hereinabove extracted interim order dated 28.05.2024, is hereby made **absolute**, subject to the hereinafter extracted conditions:-

- “(i) the petitioner shall not commit an offence similar to the present offence;
- (ii) the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case;
- (iii) the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required.”

4. This order should not be treated as “blanket” order. It will not be read granting petitioner indefinite protection from arrest. It shall be confined to the FIR mentioned *ibid* and will not operate in respect of any other incident that involves commission of an offence.

5. Needless to say that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
