Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are working with the respondents on outsourcing policy but their names are not being brought on the portal of the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam, which has been made essential for recommending the names of the employees to be appointed on outsourcing basis.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners fear that they will be replaced by the other candidates whose name have already been brought on the portal of Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam, which will serve hardship upon the petitioners.
