1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to decide his appeal in a time bound manner.
2. Mr. Sameer Sachdeva, Advocate submits that petitioner has preferred an appeal before Appellate Authority against the order of dismissal. The said appeal is pending since 2018. The respondents may be directed to decide his appeal because it cannot be kept pending on the ground of pending criminal proceedings.
