Mr. B. S. Bhalla, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of
respondent No.8, by filing his Vakalatnama, and the same is taken on record.

The petitioners have filed the present petition with a prayer to
issue directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the
petitioner, as respondent No.6 was threatening the petitioner at the instance
of respondents No.8 and 9.

A further prayer was made to direct the respondent No.3 to take
action on the representation dated 04.05.2023 (Annexure P-8).

Learned State counsel submits that a representation dated
04.05.2023 (Annexure P-8) has already been considered by the Competent
Court and has been ordered to be filed.

However, it was found that it is a monetary dispute between the parties and the matter has been closed. He further submits that no complaint filed by the private respondents is pending against the present petitioner and both the parties are directed to avail their civil remedies, if any, available in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.

The parties may avail their alternative remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
