1. Petitioners-Jaswinder Singh @ Kulwinder Singh, Piya Kaur, Gurdev Kaur @ Rabia, Bhajan Kaur @ Bachno, Sona Singh @ Sonu and Saroj Rani have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.0096, dated 15.9.2021, Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur, under Sections 494, 420, 323, 506 & 120-B IPC, and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 05.02.2024, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Zira, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statement of petitioners/accused Jaswinder Singh @ Kulwinder Singh, Piya Kaur, Gurdev Kaur @ Rabia, Bhajan Kaur @ Bachno, Sona Singh @ Sonu, Saroj Rani and complainant Joginder Kaur @ Jogindero have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. Complainant Joginder Kaur @ Jogindero in her statement had stated that she has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.

5. The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Zira, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in **2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab**, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0096, dated 15.9.2021, Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur, under Sections 494, 420, 323, 506 & 120-B IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
