Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct an inquiry into the alleged fraudulent sale/transfers done by late Kanhaiya Lal (Predecessor-in-interests of respondents No.5 to 7) by executing sale deeds which already stood acquired by the State of Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on being asked, fairly concedes that the petitioner is not a person who is directly aggrieved by any of such transactions and is a whistle blower.

Under the given circumstances, the petitioner is not a party aggrieved and no right of the petitioner has been violated or any injury or damage caused to him, I am of the opinion that the present writ petition in this format is not maintainable.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition so as to file an appropriate petition in accordance with law.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
