1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant pay fixation in the 2nd ACP modified scale of Rs. 5000-7850 as admissible under the modified notification dated 20.02.2004 (Annexure P-1) as the same relief has been granted to the similarly situated employees, with a further prayer to direct the respondents to grant the benefit of abovesaid modified 2nd ACP to the petitioner and re-fix the retiral benefits including pension and release the arrears from due date alongwith interest @ 12 % per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondents No.1



and 2 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) is considered and decided by respondents No.1 and 2 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P-5) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
