DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

(1) Learned senior counsel appearing for the appellants submits that in terms of the liberty granted in the impugned judgment by the learned Single Judge, the appellants shall file an impleadment application before respondent No.1 in the pending revision petition filed by respondent No.4 to challenge therein letter/order dated 02.02.2024 of the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, Panchkula (for short, the Registrar) and that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present appeal is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the appellants' aforesaid application in a time bound manner with a further direction to respondent No.1 to thereafter also expeditiously decide the main revision petition.

(2) Learned State counsel has no objection to the acceptance of the alternate prayer made on behalf of the appellants.

(3) The alternate prayer made on the appellants' behalf is found to be reasonable. Even otherwise, a decision to expeditiously decide a *lis* between the contesting parties prejudices none. Therefore, and because the learned State counsel has no objection to its acceptance, the instant appeal is disposed of with a direction that if and when an application is filed by the appellants seeking therein



their impleadment in the pending revision petition preferred by respondent No.4 to challenge therein letter/order of the Registrar dated 02.02.2024, respondent No.1 shall consider and decide the same within ten days of its filing, in accordance with law. The main revision petition is also directed to be finally decided within two weeks thereafter.

(4) All pending miscellaneous applications also stand disposed of.
