SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside orders dated 23.01.2019, Annexure P-8, and 15.03.2018, Annexure P-5, passed by respondents No.2 and 3.
2. Upon notice, writ petition has been contested by the respondents by filing a separate written statement. An objection has been taken that the petitioner has a remedy of filing a revision petition under Section 69 of the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act, 1961.
3. As the petitioner has an alternate remedy of filing a revision petition, instant petition is not maintainable. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the remedy available to it in accordance with law.
4. Petition is dismissed with liberty as aforesaid.
