HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful disobedience of order dated 06.03.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-14372-2023.
2. In response, separate replies on behalf of respondents No.2 and 4 have been filed in Court today and the same are taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that aforesaid order dated 06.03.2024 has been complied with, thereby, rendering the present petition as infructuous.
4. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press

the present petition.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed.

However, in case any cause survives, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter.

6. Rule stands discharged.
