1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 23.11.2020 (Annexure P-1) whereby he was dismissed from service; order dated 24.05.2021 (Annexure P-2) whereby his appeal has been dismissed; and order dated 20.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) vide which representation filed by him has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that issue involved in the present petition is no more *res integra*. This Court vide order dated 28.02.2024 in *Tarsem Chand v. State of Punjab and others, CWP No.4591 of 2024* has decided an identical issue. He submits that present petition may be disposed of in terms of order dated 28.02.2024 in *Tarsem Chand (supra)*.



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3. Mr. Aman Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab does not oppose prayer of the petitioner and submits that appellate authority in terms of afore-cited order would re-consider case of the petitioner.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of in terms of order dated 28.02.2024 passed by this Court in *Tarsem Chand (supra)*. Let the needful be done within three months from today.
