



In view of the above, the prayer made by counsel for the petitioner is allowed. The petitioner is allowed to record his statement through SPA before the learned jurisdictional Magistrate.

Notice of motion for 22.10.2024.

At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State and Ms. Vaishali Thakur, Advocate accepts notice for respondent No.2 and admits to the factum of compromise. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Service is complete.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within four weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 22.10.2024.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. Thereafter, on 22.10.2024, the parties were again directed to appear before the jurisdictional/Illaq Magistrate within a period of two weeks. In compliance of the aforesaid orders, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC OnLine SC 834*** and ***Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63*** and Full Bench of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (CrL) 1052***, this petition



is allowed and FIR No.184 dated 19.08.2008 under Sections 363/376/34 of IPC and Section 67 of the I.T. Act, 2000 registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same are quashed, qua the petitioner.
