The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.18 dated 28.01.2020 under Section 302 IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on by Daily Diary Report No.34) and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Shri Muktsar Sahib.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 29.05.2024 and 23.07.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the orders dated 29.05.2024 and 23.07.2024 and are not required for custodial interrogation.



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In view of the above, the interim order dated 29.05.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
