This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus and for appointment of a Warrant Officer to search for the detenu-Gulshan at the premises of respondent No.4.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar submits that statement of petitioner’s wife, namely, Gulshan was got recorded, wherein it has been mentioned that she has married with respondent No.4, namely, Laldeen.

Further, a perusal of the order sheet reveals that there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing. Same is the situation today.
