KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent No.4 who is a police official presently posted at CIA staff Bathinda forcibly snatched a mobile phone from Ramandeep Singh son of the petitioner on 14.12.2023, when there was a fight between two other persons and Ramandeep Singh had tried to capture the same in his mobile phone. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that even thereafter respondent No.4 is regularly giving threats to petitioner and his son and has not returned the aforesaid mobile phone till date and in this regard representation dated 15.12.2023 Annexure P-1 is already submitted to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary directions is given to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-1 of the petitioner in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 15.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
