 This is an application filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay of 70 days in filing the appeal.

 For the reasons stated in the application and in view of the no objection from the respondent-Insurance Company, the same is allowed and the delay of 70 days in filing the present appeal is condoned.

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 As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.18,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellant-Hakam S/o Deenu, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

 Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.18,00,000/- favouring the appellant-Hakam S/o Deenu with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant’s counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

 Appeal stands disposed of.
