1. By this common order, the above-said petitions are disposed of as issues involved and prayer sought in all the petitions are common. For the sake of convenience and with the consent of parties, the facts are borrowed from CWP-16044-2019.

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2. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of Award dated 26.10.2018 whereby Labour Court has answered the reference against the Management.

3. Counsel for respondent No. 2 submit that vide judgment dated 13.05.2024, this Court dismissed identical petitions of the petitioners herein. The petitioners preferred Intra Court Appeals. A Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 08.08.2024 has dismissed a bunch of Appeals including LPA-1849-2024 (O&M). The instant case is squarely covered by the judgments of Hon'ble Single Judge as well as Division Bench of this Court.

4. On being confronted with above-mentioned judgments, Mr. Rahul Dev Singh, Advocate expressed his inability to controvert the applicability of the same to the instant petitions.

5. As the issue involved in the instant petition is squarely covered by afore-cited judgments of this Court, the petitions deserve to be dismissed and accordingly dismissed.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
