1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to take action in case FIR No.96 dated 18.02.2016 under Section 365 of the IPC registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurgaon, or to hand over the investigation of the case to some independent agency like CBI etc. and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family at the hands of private respondent No.6.

2. In compliance of order dated 19.07.2024, status report by way of affidavit of Naveen Sharma, HPS, assistant Commissioner of Police, Udyog Gurugram, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel opposite.



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3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the FIR in question has been lodged by the petitioner-complainant as his son Pardeep @ Gajraj had gone missing. While drawing the attention of this Court to the status report filed today, learned State counsel submits that extensive efforts were made by the police, including independent agency like STF, to trace the son of the petitioner, however, he could not be traced.

4. In view of the status report filed by the State, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition, which is disposed of accordingly.

5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail of alternate remedies as may be available to him under the provisions of law.
