Present set of two writ petitions involve common question of law in the background of common set of facts and thus they are being decided by a common order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the question of law raised in the present set of petitions was also raised in CWP No.22223 of 2024 titled ***“Dr. Janmeet Tosy and ors. Vs. State of Punjab and anr.”*** which has been disposed of on 05.09.2024, wherein a direction has been given to consider the claim of the employees concerned for the grant of benefit as being claimed under Dynamic Assured Career Progression Scheme.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that as direction had already been given, the petitioner(s) also intends to move comprehensive representations claiming the same benefit and the claim of the present petitioners be also considered while deciding the claim in terms of ***Dr. Janmeet Tosy’s case (supra)***.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, any representation(s) at the hands of the petitioner(s), the same will also be considered by forming an opinion with regard to the claim of the petitioner(s) keeping in view the directions given in ***Dr. Janmeet Tosy’s case (supra)***. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition(s) may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with the liberty to file representation(s) with the respondents.

CWP-15875-2019 (O&M) and other connected case

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Till the fresh decision is taken, the status quo shall be maintained as on today.

Ordered accordingly.
