NAMIT KUMAR ,J. (ORAL)

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This is an application filed under Section 151 CPC for placing on record written statement on behalf of the respondents.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Written statement on behalf of the respondents is taken on record.

Main case

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the charge sheet dated 07.07.2006 (Annexure P-5), consequential enquiry report dated 20.06.2007 (Annexure P-7) and punishment order dated 16.04.2008/05.05.2008 (Annexure P/9) imposing a punishment of dismissal on an already dismissed employee alongwith recovery and also quashing the orders



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dated 09.01.2015 (Annexure P-11), 10.03.2015/16.03.2015 (Annexure P-12), 23.08.2016 (Annexure P-14) and 29.11.2016/17.01.2017 (Annexure P-15), whereby despite the matter having been remanded back twice by the Appellate Authority, the punishing authority again imposed punishment of dismissal upon an employee who had already been dismissed from service vide order dated 30.09.2004/04.10.2004 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the order dated 06.08.2024 having endorsement dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure A-1), the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Disposed of as having become infructuous.

4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to take appropriate measures with regard to his retiral benefits, in accordance with law.
