The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking grant of parole of six weeks for the treatment of liver disease of the son of the petitioner named Agam Singh (age 7 years) as his son is suffering from serious disease of liver.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jaspal Singh Guru, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, who has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner today in Court, which is taken on record and informs the Court that the petitioner has never represented to the competent authority for seeking parole of six weeks on account of ailment of his son.

On the said fact, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no occasion for the authorities concerned to examine the case of the petitioner.

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to approach District Magistrate through Jail Superintendent by way of a representation which shall be adjudicated by the said authority within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of such representation in accordance with law by passing a speaking order.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
