1. Petitioners allege that both of them are major and they got married on 04.01.2024 against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7 who are related to petitioner No.1. This is their first marriage.
2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that aforesaid private respondents No. 4 to 7 have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation dated 25.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) was given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Panchkula but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from SI Ashish Kumar submits that respondents No.4 to 6 who are parents and uncle of petitioner No.1 have recorded their statements with the police to the effect that they are not against the marriage of the petitioners and that they never gave any threat to

cause harm to the petitioners.

5. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioners submits that even now the petitioners are apprehending threat from the side of private respondents. On this, the State counsel submits that in case any such representation filed by the petitioners is pending the same will be considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.

6. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Panchkula to consider representation dated 25.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

7. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
