1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has an old father to take care of and who is residing in Rohtak and the petitioner has already served for the department at the daily wages and hence, in the interest of justice, the petitioner be transferred to Rohtak especially when there is no one else than the petitioner to take care of his ailing father.
2. Learned counsel submits that the said grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner before the authorities concerned vide representations, which have been collectively attached (Annexure P-3) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, the last representation of the petitioner dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) is decided by the respondents in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.
3. Notice of motion.



4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) has been received in the office of concerned authorities and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of **six** weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the representation, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will also be released to him otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
7. Ordered accordingly.
