1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 14.11.2019 passed in CWP-6091-2014.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Ajoy Sharma, Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Local Govt., Punjab, Chandigarh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 14.11.2019 passed in CWP-6091-2014 has been complied with and necessary payment has been made to the petitioner.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
