1. By way of present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to the official respondents for providing protection to the petitioner at the hands of police officials of Police Station Adampur Distt. Jalandhar and some unknown and unidentified persons.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the allegations made in the present petition and decide the same by passing a speaking order expeditiously.
3. Prayer seems to be justified.
4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Athar Ahmed, DAG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.
5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Distt. Jalandhar, Punjab to look into the

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allegations levelled in the present petition by treating the same as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks’ from the date of receipt of certified copy of this petition along with the order.
