KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. The prime grievance of the petitioner, as contained in the instant petition relates to registration of FIR No.44 dated 17.2.2023 under Sections 120-B, 34, 404, 406, 420, 468, 471 IPC, Police Station Civil Line, Sonapat as a consequence of order dated 3.2.2023, whereby, the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, concerned, after sending the complaint under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C., directed to register a case. In consequence, the petitioner seeks quashing of the FIR (supra).
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by the official concerned, informs this Court that after conducting thorough investigation, cancellation report has been prepared, which is likely to be presented before the learned Ilaqa Magistrate/trial Court.
3. In view of the above statement of the learned State counsel, no further interference is required, as the instant petition is rendered infructuous.
4. Consequently, the instant petition is dismissed, as having rendered infructuous, however, with liberty to the petitioner to re-access this Court in case any grievance still exists.
