1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 08.11.2023 passed in CRM-M-56182-2023.
2. There is no provision in the Criminal Procedure Code for making representation as such, therefore, there is no scope for issuing any direction to the Police to consider and decide the representation *de hors* order for fair investigation of the case. However, there is no order for investigation of the case, as such.
3. Accordingly, even if the petitioner is entitled to some other remedy, this Court does not find the present case fit for punishing the Police for contempt of Court, as such.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy before any other appropriate Court.
