1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to take legal actions against respondents No.5 to 7, after considering the inquiry report (Anneuxre P-10).
2. Reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4 and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel submits that the opinion has been taken from ADA (Legal), Ferozepur and it has been found that it is a case of civil nature and the petitioner has been advised to avail his appropriate remedies before the Civil Court. He further contends that the file has been consigned to the record room after completing the necessary proceedings.
4. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further orders are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.

5. Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail his alternative remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
