1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 17.09.2019 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2.
2. Learned State Counsel has pointed out that all common witnesses except one have been examined in the departmental proceedings and one common witness who was left i.e. PW4 Ajeet Singh, DSP has been examined in the criminal trial.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition, with liberty to the petitioner to take up all the points which are available to him, in accordance with law, before the departmental proceedings.
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
