RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 21.11.2018 passed in CWP-29471-2018.
2. Amended memo of parties filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Reply dated 26.09.2023 by way of affidavit of C. Jayasharadha, IAS, SDO (Civil), Naraingarh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
4. Counsel for respondent No.4 has submitted that the amount has been paid to the petitioner and, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
5. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
