1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India praying for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

2. In light of the status report filed by the State, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no threat perception to the petitioner as of now. However, qua the second prayer, the official respondents are not proceeding in the complaint filed by him but he prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

3. In light of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to avail his appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and the liberty granted, if any, is only on the request of the counsel for the petitioner and is not a direction.
