1. Prayer in the present writ petition is for directing respondent No.2-State of Punjab through Chief Secretary, to get refund of the money transferred from the building and other construction Welfare Board fund to respondent No. 4 for vaccination of the registered/non-registered workers as the act of the respondents was in violation of the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in contempt petitions No. 41, 42, 43 and 44 of 2011 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 318 of 2006.

2. Learned State Counsel appearing on behalf of respondents



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No.2 to 4 submits that all the dues have been cleared and nothing remains outstanding as on today.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners still prays that the present writ petition may be treated as representation and the respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

4. Learned State Counsel has no objection to the same.

5. Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and to decide the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in his favour within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
