1. The prayer made in the present petition is for direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to release the pensionary benefits and family pension to petitioner No.1 and 2 and respondent No.5 in the proportion of 1/3rd each.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions from Shamsher Singh, Conductor No.130 submits that Rs.6,78,741/- has been released to petitioner No.1 and respondent No.5 as well, however, the same amount shall be released to respondent No.2 within a period of 3 weeks. Insofar as the pensionary benefits, which are to be released to petitioner No.2, the Department has already vide letter dated 26.07.2024, forwarded it to the Principal, Accountant General, Haryana-respondent No.3, with regard to which, learned counsel appearing for it, on instructions states that the needful shall be done within a period of 2 months.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to abide by the compromise dated 25.08.2022, Annexure P-8, as per which, Rs. 8 lacs has to be paid to respondent No.5, after receipt of the pensionary benefits, which satisfies the said respondent.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is disposed of accordingly. For claim of interest, if any, parties are left to represent to the respondents.
