By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in compliance to the order dated 31.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioners may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Arvind



has intimated that the petitioners have joined investigation and are no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor they are required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 31.05.2024 the following order was passed:-

“2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case by the police. He contends that no specific overt act is attributed to the petitioners and even the petitioners were granted concession of interim bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad, as is evident from the order dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure P-8). He contends that however, the petitioners could not join the investigation due to ill health of their uncle and on this score, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad, dismissed the bail application vide order dated 21.05.2018 (Annexure P-9). He contends that the petitioners are ready to join the investigation and are not facing any other criminal case.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and does not dispute the factual matrix of the case and prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter.

5. Adjourned to 18.07.2024.

6. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

7. In the meanwhile, the petitioners are hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of their arrest, they are ordered to be released on interim bail on their furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. They shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioners had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 31.05.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail



granted vide order dated 31.05.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioners are directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioners; they will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
