1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 270 dated 27.10.2017 under Sections 376, 384, 506 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.
2. Office report indicates that *dasti* notice issued to respondent No. 2 has not been received back either served or otherwise. On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner sought adjournment for filing power of attorney with endorsement of No-Objection from the previous counsel.
