- Through the instant petition, filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.26 dated 11.03.2024 under Sections 21, 21 (C) and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).
- Vide order dated 29.05.2024, passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
- Learned State counsel, in terms of the status report filed today in Court, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 08.06.2024 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.
- Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.05.2024, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
