By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who are apprehending threats to their life at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that Om Parkash, late husband of petitioner No.1 and father of petitioner No.2 went missing on 03.03.2024 and the FIR No.76 dated 05.03.2024 registered under Section 346 and 302 of IPC at P.S. Agroha, District Hisar (Annexure P-1) was registered. He contends that the petitioner had moved the representation dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Hisar, but no action thereon has been taken in order to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the FIR. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to



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respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, District Hisar, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has apprised that after conclusion of investigation, challan has been prepared.
- 5. After hearing the respective submissions and perusing the record, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, District Hisar, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 22.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.
- 6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.
- 7. Disposed of.
