1. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant writ petition.
2. Leave granted. Consequently, the extant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
3. The determined compensation amount in respect of the subject lands shall be positively released to the present petitioner, but on an application in the above regard being filed before the authority wherebefore whom the said compensation amount is lying deposited.

It is further clarified that the release of the compensation amount shall be made to the present petitioner only after proper verification of the entitlement of the present petitioner to the said claimed compensation amount. However, it shall be released through remission in the savings bank account of the present petitioner but against proper receipt and identification.
