1. Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 18.10.2011 (Annexure P-12) whereby petitioner was placed under suspension and order dated 31.05.2012 (Annexure P-17) passed by the Education Tribunal, vide which the appeal of the petitioner against the order of suspension has been disposed of and the order dated 15.06.2012 (Annexure P-19) passed by respondent No.1 whereby suspension order has been extended for six months.

2. Learned State counsel submits that instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the suspension order of the petitioner has already been revoked vide order dated 11.07.2013 and she has been allowed to join the institution. In pursuance to the said revocation of the suspension order, petitioner has joined on 12.07.2013 (Annexure R-1).
