This second petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case bearing FIR No.0066 dated 17.04.2022 under Sections 324/323/148/149 of IPC (offence under Section 302 of IPC added subsequently vide rapat No.15 dated 24.04.2022 and offence under Section 120-B of IPC added subsequently vide rapat No.28 dated 24.04.2022) registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka. First petition was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 07.02.2024.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that now four more accused have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and the trial has commenced *de novo* and the petitioner is behind the bars for the last two years. He further wishes to withdraw the present petition and confines his prayer to the extent that a time bound direction be issued to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of six months.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, the learned trial Court is directed to decide the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
