1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the salary/remuneration of the higher post of Assistant Engineer w.e.f. 05.09.2008 to 19.07.2010 in view of office order dated 05.09.2008 (Annexure P-1) issued by the respondents vide which the petitioner was ordered to work as JE-1 CDC of Divisional Store, Kaithal and for the period from 09.04.2013 to 07.11.2017 in view of office order dated 08.04.2013 (Annexure P-2) passed by the respondents vide which the petitioner was ordered to work as Assistant Engineer Provisional 'OP' I/A Sub Division Sonipat but was paid the salary and remuneration for the post of JE-I.



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had submitted a representation dated 19.09.2023 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.5 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid representation dated 19.09.2023 (Annexure P-7) is considered and decided by respondent No.5 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5/competent authority to consider and decide the representation dated 19.09.2023 (Annexure P-7) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
