The instant application has been filed for seeking preponement of the date of hearing in the main petition, which is otherwise fixed for 11.03.2024. The application is supported by an affidavit of Accounts-cum-Legal Advisor, Punjab State Industrial Development Corporation Limited, Chandigarh.

In view of the averments made in the application, the same is allowed as prayed for. The main case is preponed from 11.03.2024 and taken on Board of this Court for hearing today itself.

Main case:

The instant petition has been filed for directing respondent No.1 to discharge its obligations as of guarantor, of timely payment of principle & interest.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the entire principal amount along with interest due and interest for delayed period has already been paid to the petitioner and thus, the present petition has become infructuous.
